

## **TRIPLE PLAY ... an Air Safety Gifting Opportunity**

Erral was my flying lady; a perfect partner in the cockpit. She spent thousands of hours in the right seat of our airplanes, and she learned to fly herself, soloing in 1964 at Salem, Oregon. She knew as much about navigation and flying as I did.

She was also my maintenance partner, knowing always which wrench to use, and holding the gauges for leakage checks on our cylinders while I held the prop. As a team, we kept our airplanes in good condition, and she enhanced our safety in the air by trading off with pilot duties when I needed a break.

Our three children become pilots and aircraft owners too. So, naturally, aviation safety was given top priority in our family.

About 16 years ago we began contributing to the AOPA Air Safety Foundation because we believed in its mission: *Safe Pilots - Safe Skies*. While our gifts were financially modest, nonetheless they expressed our passionate belief in air safety.

Sadly, Erral passed away in 2003. It was so sudden, we were totally unprepared. In lieu of flowers, we suggested gifts to the AOPA Air Safety Foundation might be appropriate. It was very heartening to see the contributions begin, even from some who knew us only indirectly.

Before long, those gifts added to ours and were enough to establish a permanent memorial for Erral at the AOPA Air Safety Foundation. It is known as the **Erral Lea Plymate Memorial Endowment** and is part of ASF's "Giving Societies", a unique concept that generates perpetual income for air safety, programs from which we all benefit. Erral would like this too. She always supported ASF with our joint gifts, and the endowment option enables donors to have their gifts keep on giving -- year after year.
